Title: 10 words maximum

Please keep it simple; make it obvious what your session is about - e.g. Strategies for Making Learning Chinese Characters Fun.

Description: 300 words maximum (or about 400 Chinese characters) excluding references Please submit a brief description of the focus of your session and bullet point the 3-5 things that participants will gain from attending your session.

Personal Information: Name, Title and Affiliation

The complete papers are not to be submitted. After the conference, written papers can be submitted for publication in the association's online journal. There will be a separate review and selection of papers prior to publication.
