We are glad to announce that the 6th Critical Approaches to Discourse Analysis across Disciplines Conference (CADAAD) will take place **4-6 July 2018** and will be hosted by Aalborg University, Denmark.

CADAAD conferences are intended to promote current directions and new developments in crossdisciplinary critical discourse research. We welcome papers which, from a critical-analytical perspective, deal with contemporary social, scientific, political, economic, or professional discourses and genres.
