

## Teaching English as a Foreign Language Program Faculty Position

The <u>Teaching English</u> as a <u>Foreign Language (TEFL) Program</u> at <u>Middle East Technical University Northern</u> <u>Cyprus Campus (METU NCC)</u> invites applications for a full-time faculty position in English Language Teaching (ELT) and applied linguistics.

The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching compulsory and elective courses both in undergraduate and graduate programs in ELT. These courses may include but are not limited to language skill-oriented courses for pre-service teachers (e.g., Contextual Grammar and Composition, among others) and methodology and specialty courses in ELT (e.g., Teaching Language Skills, Translation Studies, among others). The ability to teach introductory level linguistics classes is not required, but desired. Please see <u>undergraduate</u> and <u>graduate</u> curricula for a complete list of courses offered by the TEFL program.

A Ph.D. in hand is required. Rank is open, commensurate with qualifications and experience. Applicants should have advanced degrees in teaching English as a foreign/second language, or other relevant educational disciplines (e.g., applied linguistics, second language education, curriculum and instruction), that clearly demonstrate the ability to successfully teach such courses.

The area of research for this position is open, but applicants must be actively engaged in research and publication. If hired, the successful candidate will be expected to continue to publish in internationally recognized, peer-reviewed venues and attend international symposia in support of METU NCC's research goals.

The position is full-time and will be available for Fall 2017 semester, starting in mid-September 2017 or such other date that is mutually agreed. Priority will be given to applications received by <u>February 28th, 2017</u>.

Applications must be submitted on-line after visiting the <u>METU NCC Guidelines for Application to Faculty Positions</u>.

METU NCC is committed to high quality research, teaching and service. Regular teaching load at METU NCC is 3 courses (equivalent to 9 credit hours) per semester. The TEFL Program offers B.A. and M.A. degrees in English Language Teaching, and prepares individuals to serve as certified English teachers at various levels and contexts.
