Submissions should contain mainly new material and must not have been published previously in order to be considered.

Proposal acceptances will be sent by March 18, 2017. The author(s) whose proposals have been accepted for the ILA Annual Conference must register before the March 28 registration deadline in order to be included in the Conference Program.
