- Author names, titles, and abstracts (300 words max) of the papers you plan to have in the special issue, OR a description of the process you will undertake to call for papers.

• Please outline how you plan to conduct a peer review process (please note that JLIE papers must be peer-reviewed. For special issues, guest editors are responsible for the peer review process.)

Timeline:

- Please outline the deadlines for the following steps:
 - Initial submission
 - First peer reviews
 - o Revisions

 - \circ Submission of the final manuscripts to JLIE
- Please note that we are planning to publish this special issue in the second half of 2020. In order to complete the production for the last issue (Issue 6) of the year, all complete manuscripts must be submitted by August 15, 2020.
