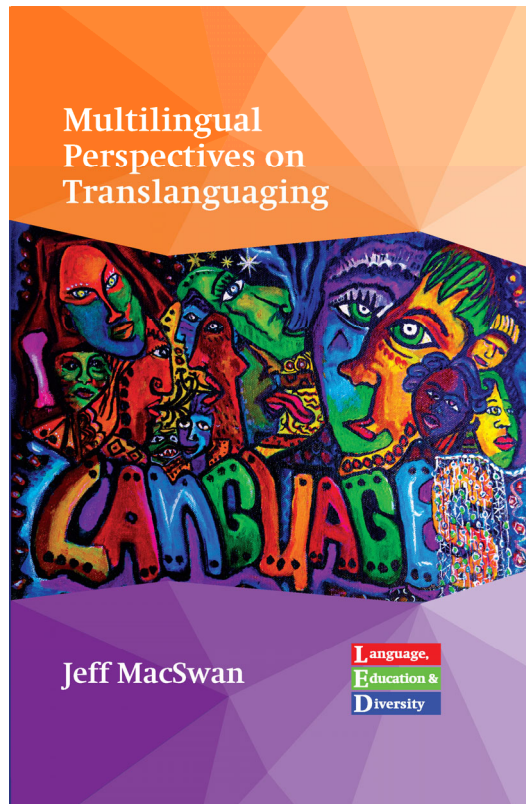


Announcing a New Edited Volume
