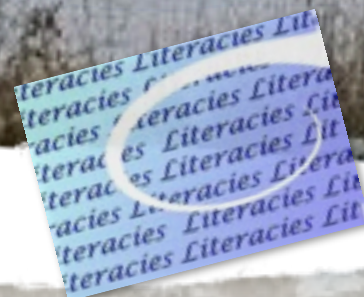

We give a welcome to research students as well as distinguished academics with plenty of time for discussion between and within sessions.

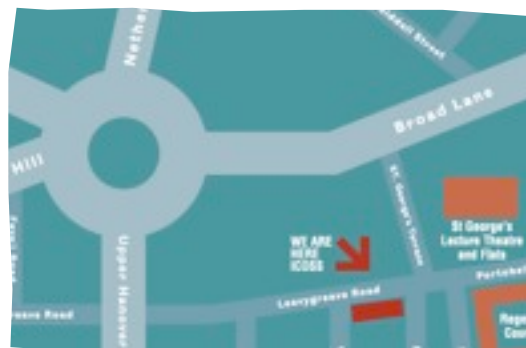
- Research students are invited to send in abstracts for consideration in Pecha Kucha sessions;
