

Research Participants Needed

English, Spanish, or Russian Speakers

PhD research aim: To better understand the intersection of language and gender by speakers of English as a first language and English as an additional language.

Participant requirements:

- To be aged 18 to 39
- To be attending a UK university in the South East
- To be a first language speaker of English, Spanish, or Russian
- To be a from the UK, Spain, or Russia

Participation involves:

Four parts over two days: background questionnaire, two tasks, and a follow-up interview

Day 1: There are two parts for you to complete on your own and one part to complete with the researcher. The first part is a background questionnaire which should take 5-10mins to complete and the second is a writing task which should take 20-30mins to complete. The final part is a speaking task to be completed with the researcher, which should take 20-30mins to complete.

Day 2: There will be one final part for you to complete with the researcher. This will be a follow-up interview which should take 30-40mins to complete.

All data is treated confidentially, including each participant being given a pseudonym (a different name)
