**The gathering will consist of many cultural and traditional activities—see poster. The main goal is to share our similarities in language, culture and tradition and pass this knowledge to the People, especially our youth.**

Who can participate? **Any interested youth or adults are welcome to participate. We will have presentations for youth and adults.**
