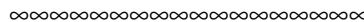


WORKSHOP SERIES OVERVIEW

The objectives of the Indigenous Language Institute’s “Language and Tech-Knowledge Workshop Series” are to provide local community people, teachers, and organizations Native language environments.

This workshop series has been developed through the generous corporate sponsorship of IBM. With IBM’s support, ILI has expanded the scope of its language services that it provides to Native communities throughout the United States and Canada. ILI has conducted 6 IBM sponsored workshops in locations such as Green Bay, WI (Oneida), Tahlequah, OK (Cherokee), in Hollywood, FL (Seminole) and Winona State University, in Winona, MN.

17 tribes have been represented at these workshops.



WORKSHOP TRAINING PROCESS

This three-day workshop offers hands-on training and computer lab experience with instructors providing participants with practical technology skills to create innovative and community-specific print materials using Microsoft Publisher software. Participants will leave this workshop with a Native language storybook and other teaching materials which they have created for their

communities.

A typical three-day workshop is as follows:

Day 1—Implementation and use of Native language keyboards developed and provided by ILI.

Day 2— Creation of storybooks and other language teaching materials.

Day 3—Completion of projects and “Sharing Circles”.

Participants will find the workshop experience engaging, stimulating and rewarding.
