This class will offer an overview of recent language teaching methods and apply them to language revitalization environments.

Home Basesd Teaching and Learning Classroom: Early Childhood & Elementary Classroom: Middle School through Adult.

Materials Development

This class aids the process of teaching and learning language. Students will create an original, activity based teaching tool. We're offering 2 classess to accomdate skill levels.

Language Activism Seminar

In this class we examine ways indigenous communities carry out their language revitalization work to discover how we as individuals and collectively can become a more effective voice for language revitalization in our own lives and communities.

Youth Program

In a cohort, youth study language, linguistics and teaching methods and design and create activities to support learning.
