Applications are being accepted for a postdoctoral position or a Master's level research assistantship at the Child Study Center, Yale University. Strong candidates with a Bachelor's Degree will also be considered. This position is part of a project involving the development of an assessment for identifying language impairment in Arabic-speaking children in Saudi Arabia, in collaboration with King Faisal University. Applicants must have native or native-like language proficiency in Arabic. Strong statistical skills, a background in developmental psychology, language disorders or a related field, and prior experience managing large data sets and/or running scientific projects are desirable. Attention to detail and good inter-cultural communication skills are of utmost importance. The position is available for 12 months beginning September 1, 2011 with a possibility of renewal.
