Position Responsibilities: The successful candidate will be expected to teach undergraduate and graduate courses, supervise MA and PhD students, mentor student research, conduct and publish research, and participate in academic administration duties.

Required Qualifications:

- PhD in Speech-Language Pathology, Communication Sciences and Disorders (or other related fields such as Psychology, Cognitive Science) at time of appointment
- Expertise in one or more of the following areas: Speech Science, Acoustics and Perception, Motor Speech Disorders, Voice Disorders, Speech Anatomy and Physiology, Voice Physiology and Pathology
- Proven record of research accomplishments and the ability to secure external funding
- Academic teaching experience
- Experience in supervising M.A. (and preferably also Ph.D.) thesis students.
- Priority for applicants with Post-Doctoral training.

- CV including list of publications and teaching experience
