50 New Academic Posts at Bangor

The University of Wales, Bangor is investing in 50 new academic posts, including 23 Professorial appointments, as part of an ambitious Strategic Plan to enhance its teaching and research performance. This investment in academic posts is coupled with other far-reaching transformational changes in the University.

This is an exciting time to join the University of Wales, Bangor. It is undergoing a period of considerable growth and change which includes reorganising its academic units into 6 interdisciplinary Colleges and it has embarked on a major estates rebuilding programme. The University has also recently been successful in obtaining over £7.5m from the Higher Education Funding Council for Wales in order to develop a Research and Enterprise Partnership with the University of Wales, Aberystwyth, and to lead the Welsh Institute for Cognitive Neuroscience. Some of the positions advertised will contribute to these developments.

The University of Wales, Bangor has an exciting, open and dynamic atmosphere in which ambitious academics will thrive. The University is located in one of the most beautiful parts of the UK, in the midst of a landscape of sea, mountains, and unspoiled countryside. 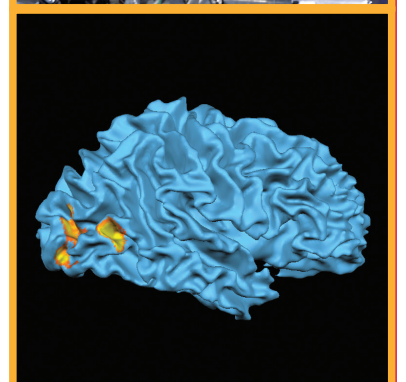
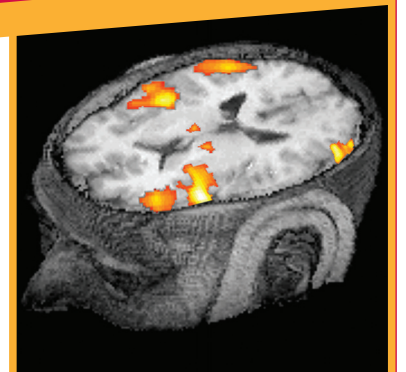
