Non-Thesis Option (30 credits):

- 9 credit hours in Latin American/Spanish/Latina(o) literatures.
- 6 credit hours in elective courses.
- 3 credit hours in a final project.
- Comprehensive exams.

Admissions

- Minimum of four (4) courses at the advanced undergraduate level in either Spanish and/or Latin American literature, Hispanic linguistics, or a combination.
- An academic writing sample in Spanish.
- Statement of Purpose.
- Three letters of recommendation.
- Official transcripts.
