



CALL FOR CHAPTER PROPOSALS

for an edited volume:

The Many Faces of Bilingualism – Living with Two Languages



We are expecting cutting-edge and innovative papers based on research in the field of bilingualism. The volume we are planning to edit will consist of 10 to 12 chapters. We have already received contributions from Malta, the UK, the USA, Ukraine, Hungary and Poland and are planning to accept a few more from those submitted.

Book rationale:

Bilingualism has become an increasingly common global phenomenon especially in the last two decades. Hence bilingual programmes have now been regarded as a cornerstone of education systems in many countries around the world. Learning two languages helps us plug into a globalised world and strengthen links with a multitude of speakers from a diversified reality we live in. We hold the view that further research needs to be conducted to enhance developments aimed at fostering bilingual practices in the contemporary world, for we are standing on the threshold of multilingualism and new policies will soon be implemented.

Chapters will preferably deal with one of the following research topics/issues:

1. Bilingual Education
2. Bilingualism and Language Teaching (e.g. CLIL)
3. Language Policies Related to Bilingualism
4. Language Contact and Bilingualism

5. Bilingualism and Emotions
6. Identity of Bilingual Speakers
7. Early Bilingualism
8. Bilingualism and Heritage Languages
9. Bilingualism in the Intercultural World
10. From Bilingualism to Multilingualism

Chapter proposals

A chapter proposal should be approximately 150-200 words in length. The proposal should report original research not published before. Priority will be given to empirical papers. All proposals should include:

- author: full name, contact details, affiliation
- chapter title
- primary/secondary aim of the chapter
- theoretical framework
- data and methods of analysis
- tentative conclusions
- bibliography

Deadlines:

Chapter proposal deadline: 1 April 2016

Notification of acceptance: 1 May 2016

First draft of full chapter: 1 July 2016

Final submission: 1 September 2016

Publication: 1 December 2016
