Brown University's Department of Anthropology invites applications for a Visiting Assistant Professor in Linguistic Anthropology. Candidates should have a Ph.D. in Anthropology or a related discipline within the humanities or social sciences (or ABD with a dissertation that is accepted by August 1, 2016). The successful candidate will be expected to teach four courses (an undergraduate Intro to Linguistic Anthropology course, a graduate core linguistic anthropology course, and two others according to departmental needs and the candidate's interests). The position is also available for one semester only (two courses), for any candidates who are only available for one semester. This one-year sabbatical replacement position is not renewable. Candidates should send a letter of application, curriculum vitae, and the names and addresses of three referees. Review of applications will begin May 1, 2016.

The appointment will be effective August 1, 2016.
