Submission guidelines:

Abstracts of research papers, not more than one A4 page (minimum margins: 2.5 cm or 1 inch; font size 12; Times New Roman; single spacing) must be submitted both in .pdf and .doc formats i.e **MS WORD** and **PDF both**. The abstract should start with the *title of the paper*, followed by *name of the author(s)*, *email address, affiliation abstract* and five *keywords*. Please send your abstract to icolsi2013@gmail.com or to the mailing address provided below, <u>latest by September 30, 2013</u>. Acceptance of abstracts will be communicated latest by October 15, 2013. All paper presenters have to be LSI members by the time they register for the conference.
