



# ASLAN POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIPS (2016)

The 'laboratory of Excellence' <u>ASLAN</u> Advanced Studies on Language Complexity is offering **three postdoctoral fellowships** for a period of 24 months. The candidates' research project should address ASLAN scientific goals and fit into one of the profiles listed hereafter. The grantees will be hosted in Lyon, France in either the DDL (<u>Dynamique Du Langage</u>) or ICAR (<u>Interactions, Corpus, Apprentissages, Représentations</u>) laboratory, depending on their research topics<sup>1</sup>.

## PROFILE 2016A (1 POSITION)

The candidate research project will address issues related to the complexity of language(s) or complexity issues in language interactions and human communication in the broad sense (see <u>Work Package 1</u> description).

Priority will be given to approaches based on modeling or at least quantitative methodologies. The Steering committee is open to all topics, especially on the following areas:

- "Complex Adaptive Systems" approaches applied to communication in digital communities (twitter, etc.)
- Quantification and/or regulation of linguistic information
- Modeling of emergent phenomena in communication

### PROFILE 2016B (1 POSITION)

The candidate research project will address issues related to language(s) origin, evolution, and diversity, or more generally any project relevant to <u>Work Package 2</u>.

## PROFILE 2016c (1 POSITION)

The candidate research project will address issues falling into the <u>Work Package 3</u> areas. **Priority will be given to projects on language development that also address issues on either bilingualism or pathologies.** 

## ✓ Eligibility<sup>2</sup> and Application Procedure

Applicants must have received before October, 1st, 2016 a Ph.D. or equivalent doctoral-level research degree relevant to the proposed profiles.

## ✓ Terms and Conditions

Fellows will be hired by the CNRS (Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique) on a fixed-term contract. The annual gross income will be €30,000 or more, depending on the fellow's experience. The place of work will be either the École Normale Supérieure de Lyon or the Human Sciences Institute, both located in Lyon, France.

Proposals will be evaluated for candidate achievement, project scientific merit (significance, originality), compatibility with the Research profiles, and contribution to the research team in terms of skills and scientific topics
