



Call for abstracts June, 2022

The research group *Estudios Lingüísticos Regionales* (GELIR) invites both national and international academic community to the *IV International Conference on Linguistic Research*. As in other versions, this conference will focus on discussions and linguistic research reports that cover different linguistic areas.

## Date: September 7, 8 and 9, 2022

Place: University of Antioquia (Medellín-Colombia): Main campus and Extensión Building.

## Scope of the conference:

- Promote academic discussions about linguistic research and propose new ones.
- Contribute to the professional development for teachers, researchers, and students in the linguistic area.
- Expand multiple methodological possibilities and linguistic processing data from computing tools and resources.
- Share linguistic research results to the national and international academic community.
- Use the linguistic research results for language teaching purposes.

# Types of participation:

- Guest speakers: three speakers will be invited to give a talk about linguistic issues. Length: 75 minutes (60 minutes for presenting and 15 minutes for questions)
- **Presentations:** presenters will share partial or final research results. A maximum of two presenters per presentation are accepted. **Length:** 30 minutes (20 minutes for presenting and 10 minutes for questions)
- Workshops: presenters might offer workshops based on linguistic issues. Proposals must be sent in the same dates of submission. Description of the workshop, types of activities, requirements, and number of attendees should be included in each proposal.

Length: 60 minutes

 Posters: presenters will display in a fast and concise way their linguistic research results. A maximum of one presenter per poster is accepted and the size for the poster must be 90cms x 120cms.
Length: during the Congress'dates.

## Guide for proposals presentation:

Presentations, posters, or workshops proposals should be sent in the official languages of the Conference, Spanish or English, to the e-mail: <u>congresogelir@udea.edu.co</u> Please send the proposals in Word format not later than July 1, 2022.

Proposals must have a maximum of 500 words, simple spacing, Times New Roman, 12 points font size.

The proposals submitted to the Conference will follow a peer-reviewing process. The accepted proposals could be part of the journal Lingüística y Literatura if presenters for general guidelines authors accept to follow the on this link (https://revistas.udea.edu.co/index.php/lyl/about/submissions#authorGuidelines). The journal will publish a special issue derived from the Conference on the second semester in 2023.

Note: presenters must register before August 10th, 2022, in order to be included in the Conference academic program.

In case you need an institutional invoice, it is vital to send the following information to the e-mail of the Conference:





- 1. An official letter of commitment from the academic institution on letterhead and signed, requesting the invoice from Universidad de Antioquia. It is important to specify the name of the participant, ID card number, and name of the Conference.
- 2. An updated identification document from the university that will make the payment.
- 3. Fill out this form (legal person form) and let us know when it is done.
- 4. Institutional phone number and address.
- 5. Participant's full name, identification number, cellphone, and e- mail.
- 6. Participant's fee category.

When resquesting an invoice, please note that:

- Universidad de Antioquia will send the invoice in two formats: 1. Attached in the form and 2. On PDF by e-mail.
- The payment can be made after you get the invoice, not before.
- The payment can be made in different ways: 1. By international transfer, 2. Online with ATM card or 3. In one of the banks shown in the invoice.

Public institutions that need an invoice must send a legal budget booked letter to the mail: congresogelir@udea.edu.co.

If the payment is made online, the registration receipt will be sent to the person who made the transaction. Changing names is troublesome.

Important: if you need an invoice in the name of your institution, it is important to request it before the registration to the Conference.
