

The EYDO leads a team of Miriwoong women in developing the Miriwoong Early Learning Language Capacity Development project, in collaboration with local partners, including early learning centres and employment agencies.

Her/his responsibilities will focus on curriculum development in alignment with existing resources, supervision of staff in a train-the trainer context, and the transmission of linguistic and pedagogical skills.

Prerequisites are the acquisition of a Working with Children Card and National Police Clearance, a valid Australian driver's licence, native speaker fluency in English, Australian citizenship or permanent residency with full work rights, and a firm commitment for 30 months of employment in this position.
