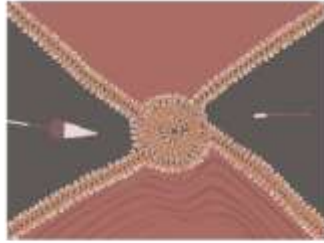

Vacancy at Mirima Dawang Woorlab-gerring Language and Culture Centre

MDWg is looking for a suitably qualified and experienced person to fill the role of *Early Years Development Officer* (EYDO) to take over the coordination of a new initiative as part of our organisation's language revitalisation program. The EYDO leads a team of Miriwoong women in developing the Miriwoong Early Learning Language Capacity Development project, in collaboration with local partners, including early learning centres and employment agencies.

The EYDO's responsibilities will focus on guiding the team in the delivery of daily immersion-based Miriwoong language sessions at a new early learning centre, develop a train-the-trainer program to incorporate language learning in a formal certificate in collaboration with a partner organisation, and the transmission of linguistic and pedagogical skills for the early years context.

Prerequisites are the acquisition of a Working with Children Card and National Police Clearance, a valid Australian driver's licence, native speaker fluency in English, Australian citizenship or permanent residency with full work rights, and a firm commitment to stay in this position until at least 30 June 2025.

This is a full-time Level 4 position (SACS-WA), subject to qualification and experience, based in Kununurra (Western Australia).
