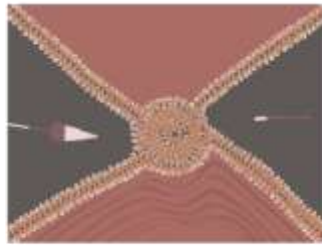

About the Role

MDWg is looking for a motivated and committed person to fill the role of Coordinator/Language Education Facilitator to manage the delivery of the upper primary division (Yr 3-6) of the Miriwoong Language Program. The coordinator leads a team of Miriwoong educators and supports the delivery of the Miriwoong language program in conjunction with the coordinator of the lower primary division (Kindy-Yr 2).

This is a full-time Level 4 position (SACS-WA), subject to qualification and experience, based in Kununurra (Western Australia). We are prepared to discuss a Level 5 appointment with a highly qualified and experienced candidate.

Key Responsibilities:

- Manage a team of Miriwoong educators and supervise the delivery of the Miriwoong Language Program, including supporting the preparation and delivery of lessons, and coordinating logistical matters
- Provide and support professional development opportunities for Miriwoong educators, with particular focus on teaching skills and curriculum planning
- Attend to administrative duties associated with the Miriwoong Language Program, such as writing reports for schools and funding bodies

Requirements for the Role:

- A Western Australian Working with Children Card and National Police Clearance (or willingness to obtain these)
- An Australian driver's licence
- Fluency in English
- Australian citizenship or permanent residency with full work rights
- A commitment for at least 2 years of employment in this position

About Mirima Dawang Woorlab-gerring:

MDWg is a not-for-profit community-controlled organisation whose main objective is to document, support and strengthen the languages of the Miriwoong and Gajirrabeng peoples. MDWg has been in operation since the 1970s, and since 2013 has been running various education programs to support the revitalization of Miriwoong language.

MDWg is located in Kununurra, a town in the East Kimberley region of Western Australia. Kununurra is situated 40 kilometres west of the Northern Territory border, and serves as a regional centre.

If you are interested in this role, please send us a brief expression of interest and request an application kit. We will then ask you to complete your application by addressing the selection criteria. The application kit also includes details about the remuneration package.

Motivation and commitment to supporting an endangered language are crucial selection criteria and we encourage new graduates to consider applying.
